**Under this agreement for 2018
Beerwah State School will receive**

\$170,790*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the average percentage of students achieving 'C' or higher in English from 79.2% to 82%
- increase the percentage of students meeting National Minimum Standard in Year 3 NAPLAN Reading from 82% to 100%
- increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands in Year 3 NAPLAN Reading from 22% to 35%
- increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands in Year 5 NAPLAN Reading from 26% to 35%
- promote positive wellbeing programs to support student engagement in learning.

Our initiatives include:

- providing focused and intensive teaching in instructional reading groups from Prep to Year 6
- building teacher capability in using current data to inform planning, moderation and explicit teaching to meet student needs
- implementing school-based support programs to improve student learning and social outcomes.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Action	Cost
• implementing the Reboot Program for Year 3 to Year 6	\$35 000
• employing additional staff (teacher and teacher aides) to implement small group reading program using the Gradual Release Model	\$60 290
• purchasing additional teacher aide time to support wellbeing and school based support programs	\$48 000
• building teacher capacity through teacher release to work with curriculum leaders	\$27 500



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
