Beerwah State School will receive

\$152,664*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the average percentage of students achieving C or higher in English from 75% to 80%
- Increase Mean Scale Score (MSS) for Reading for Year 3 from 379 to above 427
- Increase Mean Scale Score (MSS) for Reading for Year 5 from 487 to above 509
- Promote positive wellbeing programs to support student engagement in learning.

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching in instructional reading groups from Prep to Year 6.
- Build teacher capability in using current data to inform planning, moderation and explicit teaching to meet student needs.
- Build teacher capacity to deliver and quality assure school based support programs to improve student learning and social outcomes

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ additional staff (teacher and teacher aides) to implement small group reading program using Gradual Release Model and to deliver and quality assure school based support programs to improve student learning and social outcomes. \$75 664
- Purchase additional teacher aide time to support wellbeing and school based support programs \$48 000
- Build teacher capacity through teacher release to work with curriculum leaders \$29 000
