## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 6 receiving C+ in English from 68.8% to 83%.
- Increase NAPLAN Mean Scale Score for Reading for Year 3 from 393 to above 421.
- Increase NAPLAN Mean Scale Score for Reading for Year 5 from 449 to above 462.
- Promote positive well-being programs to enhance student transitions to school, and engagement in learning.

#### Our initiatives include

- Implement Beerwah State School (BSS) Literacy Tracker as part of Annual Data Plan to ensure targeted and focussed teaching of language comprehension (decoding skills) and reading comprehension.
- Implement Structured Literacy blocks in instructional reading groups from Prep to Year 6.
- Partnership with 'Playsteps' to deliver a community playgroup to enhance Prep transition to school.
- Building teacher capability: implementing classroom Positive Behaviour Learning (PBL) systems; using data to inform class differentiation and implementing Plan B Curriculum Plans.

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

Intentional collaboration: Pre-moderation meetings for teaching teams; implementation and monitoring of PBL classroom focus including classroom profiling.	\$102,200
Additional teacher aide time: P-6 small group reading programs; community playgroup.	
Intervention programs: employing additional teacher aides to deliver programs for at risk P-2 in phonemic awareness, phonics and speech.	
Professional development in: PBL classroom focus, Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Curriculum, Science of Reading.	\$21,000
Decodable readers for Structured Literacy Blocks.	\$2 000
