This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 6 receiving C+ in English from 68.8% to 83%.
- Increase NAPLAN Mean Scale Score (MSS) for Reading for Year 3 from 411 to above 425.
- Increase NAPLAN MSS for Reading for Year 5 from 480 to above 501.
- Promote positive wellbeing programs to enhance student transitions to school, and engagement in learning.

Our initiatives include

- P-2 consistent approach to teaching phonemic awareness and phonics.
- Focused and intensive teaching in instructional reading groups from Prep to Year 6.
- Partnership with Playsteps to deliver community playgroup to enhance Prep transition to school.
- Building teacher capability to use student data to inform curriculum planning and student adjustments.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Intentional collaboration: Pre-moderation meetings for teaching teams; implementation and monitoring of PBL classroom focus including classroom profiling. \$104,411


Additional teacher aide time: P-6 small group reading programs; community playgroup.

Intervention programs: employing additional teacher aides to deliver programs for at risk P-2 in phonemic awareness, phonics and speech.
